



RULES OF BEHAVIOUR FOR VEHICLES' DRIVERS

Cars, people and vehicles can access to the terminal and therefore extreme care must be taken while circulating in the access and transit areas; in case of adverse weather conditions (rain, fog, snow, etc.), depending on the visibility, it is necessary to proceed with extreme caution, paying attention to the horizontal and vertical signs that are in the terminal, respecting the requirements indicated on the check-in documents.

During the delivery and/or pick up of the vehicles, the engine of the vehicle must absolutely be turned off.

The circulation of vehicles inside the terminal must comply with the rules of the Highway Code and all the instructions given on the vertical and horizontal safety signs placed in the terminal.

The speed must be set at maximum 10 km / h.

The traffic directions indicated by the horizontal and vertical signs or, failing that, by the terminal staff must be respected.

The circulation of vehicles on the driveways close to the tracks must take place within the yellow delimitation line.

The crossing of the tracks is allowed only in the points indicated by the horizontal signs, only after the driver checked that the track to be crossed is not affected by movements of railway vehicles.

It is absolutely forbidden to stop near the tracks and operating machines, as well as interference near the machines themselves.

Drivers of road vehicles must, in any case, give priority to pedestrians, mobile cranes, forklifts and moving wagons.

Drivers cannot request or carry out operations other than those considered by the terminal management, unless specifically authorized by the Terminal Manager.

For further explanations or clarifications regarding the above provisions, drivers can contact the Terminal Manager, before entering the terminal.

In the event that the driver has to enter the terminal without a vehicle, he must comply with the rules of conduct for regular operators and visitors to the terminal.
