



RULES OF BEHAVIOUR FOR VISITORS

Generality

- Visitors can access the terminal area only on foot and with the prior authorization of the Terminal Manager, who is available for any information or clarification.
- It is forbidden to walk on the rails and on the railroad switches.
- It is forbidden to smoke or use open flames.
- It is necessary to move sideways to the track, within the area identified by a continuous yellow strip parallel to the track.
- When a train gets near, attention must be paid to any abnormalities of the vehicles or their load (floating tarpaulin, unbalanced load, etc.) which are dangerous for one's own safety.
- It is forbidden to stop in the middle of the tracks and in the intervals, unless this is required by particular service needs.
- When the vehicles are already in motion, it is forbidden to get on or off the vehicles themselves.
- Visitors can circulate only in areas reserved for them.
- It is forbidden to enter the area intended for the temporary storage of dangerous goods.

Pedestrian traffic

- Anyone authorized to enter the terminal area must inquire and view the safety pedestrian routes, which are always the same except for particular service requirements or force majeure. In any case, when it is necessary to go outside the pre-established itineraries, it is necessary to have first thought or planned the path to follow.

Rail crossing

- The crossing of the tracks is allowed only in the points indicated by the road signs, when it is not prevented by the stop of the wagons, subject to verification that the track to be crossed is not affected by movements of rail or road vehicles.
- When the track is covered by snow, the precaution must be greater, especially for the lack of visibility of existing obstacles on the ground.
- When crossing a track at the end of a parked column, it is necessary to move at an adequate distance from the column in question, both to protect yourself from any movement of this column, and to verify that another train does not arrive on the adjacent track.



- The crossing of a parked column is allowed only to terminal employees, who will use the appropriate passages (part of the wagons are equipped with), after having ascertained that the column itself is not about to be moved and that there is no another train arriving on the adjacent track.
- It is forbidden to cross the track between stationary wagons not far from each other.

Behaviour to be taken when approaching a moving train

- Before making a manoeuvre, on the track adjacent to the pedestrian path walked, the pedestrians concerned must move to at least 1.50 meters. (Safe distance) from the nearest rail and stop; the safety distance from the wagons is highlighted by the yellow line on the ground.

Behaviour to be followed when the wagons loading and unloading operations are approaching

- The operations connected with the loading and unloading of the wagons must be carried out on the wagons parked only along the loading floors and when they have been authorized by the personnel in charge of this. In the presence of operating machines, the minimum safety distance from surrounding vehicles and / or people must be respected, taking into account the range of action of the machines themselves. Stops and interference with the operating scope in the presence of suspended loads must be avoided; the loading units must be placed in the appropriate storage areas.
